- YOUR **“YES”** vote is crucial

- **\$410,000 has already been spent** on engineering and designing new elementary building. **Further delays will increase costs** of new structure

- The **elementary building will be built** at the **current high school site**
- City Council **voted 6-0** on December 6, 2011 to vacate street
- One campus will provide **increased investment in teaching and learning**
- With **2.25% interest** on loan, this is a **great time to build** new elementary
- Several **concerned citizens** donated for ad in Miller Press **supporting new building**
- Vacating streets is **supported** by St. Ann's Catholic Church, Hand in Hand Daycare, as well neighboring residents
- One campus facility allows for **increased time for staff collaboration**
- Architects and Construction Manager have **extensive experience** in school construction and believe this **plan is the best for teaching and learning**



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
